

Sunrise Hub Training Offer

The Sunrise hub is a holistic, child-centred, and integrated approach to supporting the recovery of children and their families who have been affected by sexual abuse. We provide a service to residents and professionals in Barking & Dagenham, City & Hackney, Havering, Newham, Redbridge, Tower Hamlets and Waltham Forest. This course is being offered to the Safeguarding Partnerships across all local authorities that we work with.

Course title: Introducing the Sunrise Hub - Supporting the health and recovery of children affected by sexual abuse.

Learning objectives:

- Increased awareness of identifying and responding to Child Sexual Abuse (CSA) concerns
- Increased awareness of the CSA response pathways in the area
- Learn about the medical and emotional support needed following an allegation of sexual abuse/assault.
- Understand what is involved in a forensic medical examination (FME) and a CSA medical.
- Understand the range of services offered at the Sunrise Hub

Target audience: Social workers, social care colleagues, police colleagues, health colleagues, education colleagues, the voluntary sector, anyone working with children and young people wishing to broaden knowledge and awareness of identifying and responding to child sexual abuse working across North East London.
