About the Session

In this training we:

- Explain what 'trans' and 'non-binary' mean and describe the diversity of those who might use the terms
- Introduce key concepts crucial to understanding trans and non-binary people
- Outline the main legislation relating to trans identities
- Explore ways an organisation can work towards being trans-inclusive
- Provide links to further resources and help

The session comprises around 60 minutes of presentational material and 30 mins interactivity / Q&A. Q&A is threaded through the session to take people's queries as they arise; this enables people to bring the focus of the session onto the key issues that matter to them and particular questions they have.
